- •Conventional classical mythological iconography would likely have Mars in this place, or Minerva busily warring down the proud. Cf. Rubens' Minerva protecting Pax from Mars (1629: OGCMA0203AresAthena_Rubens)
- •Liberty, an iconographic creation of the 18th and 19th centuries, plays a major role in the message of the Capitol.
